Wednesday, December 31st @ 7pm

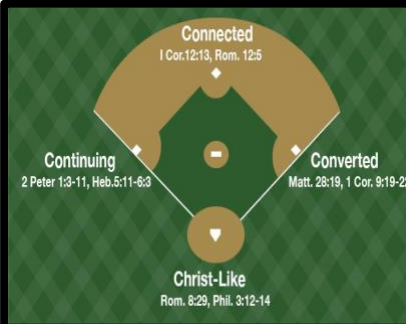
Let's welcome the New Year together!

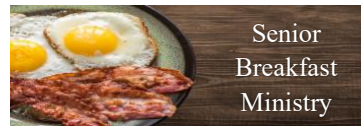


**Landmark COC has Connect Groups
