 Who are you going to invite?

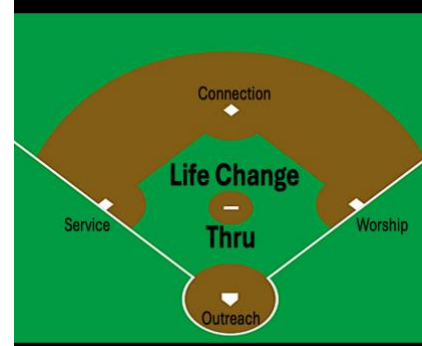

- Live Faithfully all your life (Rev. 2:10; 2 John: 9)

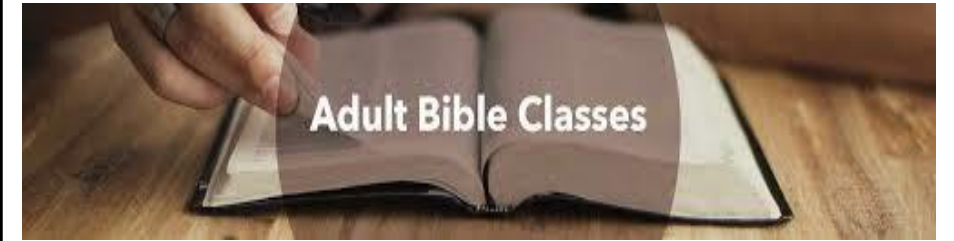

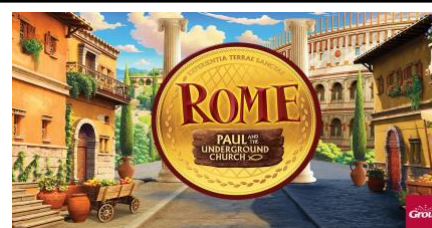

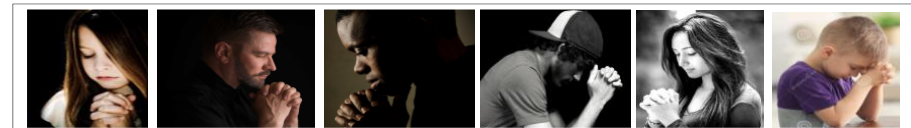
